***Did you know...**

On December 1, 1955 Rosa Parks refused to relinquish her seat on a public bus. Parks' protests galvanized the Civil Rights Movement, yet she was not the first African American individual in Montgomery to stand up against injustice in such a manner. On March 2, 1955, fifteen-year-old Claudette Colvin was riding home on a city bus after a long day at school, and the bus driver ordered Claudette to give up her seat and she refused. As she later told Newsweek "I felt like Sojourner Truth was pushing down on one shoulder and Harriet Tubman was pushing down on the other. I was glued to my seat."

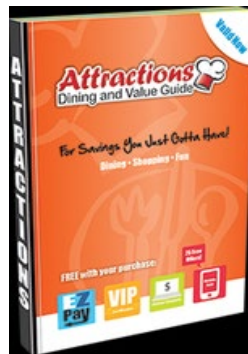

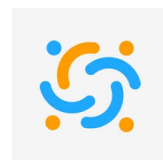


Just a Thought

AGE GROUP	HOURS PER NIGHT
Infants 4 - 12 months old	12 - 16 hours per 24 hour period
Children 1 - 2 years old	11 - 14 hours per 24 hour period
Children 3 - 5 years old	10 - 13 hours per 24 hour period
Children 6 - 12 years old	9 - 12 hours per 24 hour period
Teens 13 - 18 years old	8 - 10 hours per 24 hours
