***Did you know...**

Harriet Tubman was born a slave and raised on Maryland's Eastern Shore where the lines between slavery and freedom were often blurred. It was not unusual for families in this area to include both free and enslaved members. Harriet's own husband, John Tubman was a free black man. Her status; however, remained unchanged until she fled to Pennsylvania – a free state – in 1849. Her husband did not make the journey and ultimately re-married after Harriet's departure.

Infants 4 - 12 months old	12 - 16 hours per 24 hour period
Children 1 - 2 years old	11 - 14 hours per 24 hour period
Children 3 - 5 years old	10 - 13 hours per 24 hour period
Children 6 - 12 years old	9 - 12 hours per 24 hour period
Teens 13 - 18 years old	8 - 10 hours per 24 hours
